Mākslīgais intelekts (MI) ir jēdziens, kas attiecas uz datorprogrammām un tehnoloģijām, kas ir izstrādātas ar mērķi veidot datoriem spēju domāt un rīkoties līdzīgi cilvēkiem. Tas ietver dažādas tehnoloģijas un pieejas, kas ļauj datoriem apstrādāt un izprast informāciju, piedzīvot vidi, mācīties no pieredzes un veikt lēmumus.

Mākslīgais intelekts ir plašs jēdziens, kas ietver dažādas apakšnozares un piemērus, piemēram:

1. Dziļā mācīšanās: Šis ir viens no populārākajiem MI veidiem, kas izmanto dziļās neironu tīklu modeļus, lai analizētu un izprastu datus, tostarp attēlus, tekstu un skaņu.

Dorian's fixation with his physical beauty and youth, as well as his willingness to go to any lengths to sustain them, reflects the Decadent Movement's opposition to traditional values and its adoption of self-centeredness and self-gratification.

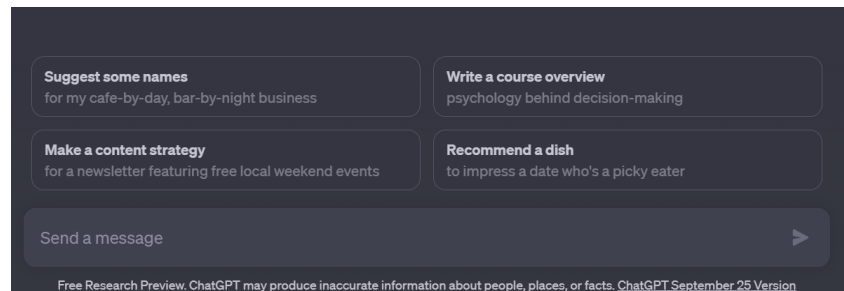
